THE BEGINNING

This is the first semi-annual newsletter for our non-profit, ***On the Move, Inc.*** In May of 2015, we began our journey.

Our mission is two fold: first, to promote *literacy* for low income minor children by providing books to help bridge the *summer reading gap/slide* while exercising their minds... and second, to promote a *healthy lifestyle*, by providing bikes to allow them to have independence and physical freedom, while exercising their bodies, stimulating their minds, and creating an adventure.

We established a small, but experienced board of directors who worked diligently over the year to build a strong foundation. One of our main initial tasks was to reach out to numerous organizations. After introducing them to ***On The Move, Inc.***, we then determined who we could partner with to best achieve our mission.

We were successful in partnering with a number of these orgs, including: School Departments, Libraries, Police Depts, Boys and Girls Clubs, etc. to identify these children, and we were able to begin fulfilling our mission by distributing books and bikes.

What is "Summer Reading Gap/Slide"?

"Summer Reading Gap" is a term used in America to describe the timeframe between the end of one school year, and the beginning of another... usually end of June to the beginning of September. The term applies to those students who are considered to be "at risk" of declining in their reading skills due to lack of book availability. (See our web page www.otminc.org for more information.)

How Important is a "BOOK BAG"?

Early in June, we got together with the Principal (Chris Balzotti) and the Reading Specialist (Lisa Follows) from the Dutile School in Billerica, MA. They were in need of specific books for the 3rd grade children. Donating the books was our pleasure, but assembling them into "BOOK BAGS" for the children to take home with them for Summer Reading (see "Summer Reading Gap") was an added plus.

When we entered the classroom to distribute the "BOOK BAGS", the children began buzzing with chatter and laughter! They could not wait to see what books they had in their bags! All the kids faces were full of smiles, and they were all more than willing to pose for this wonderful picture!
